**Bath County Wildcats roll over Nicholas Bluejackets 30-6**

CARLISLE — The Bath County Wildcats rolled into Carlisle last Friday night, Oct. 27, demolishing the Bluejackets in their final game of the regular season with a score of 30-6.

Nicholas County finished the regular season with a 4-6 record, but managed to finish in the top four in the district to make the playoffs for the first time in four years.

The first quarter in Friday night's game was fairly even, with both teams trading possessions. Bath County's Clarence Jones opened the scoring on a 24 yard sweep around the left end. The Bluejackets' Justin Massey, Coach Greg Letcher said, "It seemed that every time we got them down at 3rd or 4th and long they managed to make a big play. That kind of stuff just broke our backs."

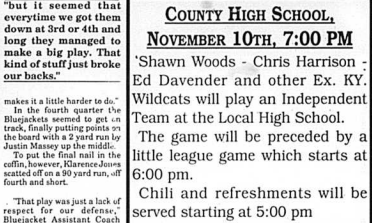

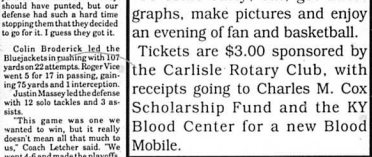
