## HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS

1. DO NOT EAT ANY TREATS UNTIL YOUR PARENTS HAVE SEEN & INSPECTED EVERYTHING IN YOUR TRICK-OR-TREAT BAG!
2. Make-up is safer, but if you wear a mask, make sure the holes are large enough to easily see and breathe through.
3. After dark take a flashlight along to see where you are going and to let drivers see you.
4. Wear costumes that are fireproof and not too long or too loose to avoid tripping.
5. Wear Bright, Reflective Colors so that Drivers Can See You When It Gets Dark.
6. Walk on sidewalks. If there are no sidewalks, walk as near to the curb as possible—keep away from moving traffic.
7. For SAFETY, TRAVEL IN GROUPS.
8. DO NOT RUN ACROSS STREETS OR RUN OUT FROM BETWEEN PARKED CARS—AND PAY ATTENTION TO TRAFFIC LIGHTS.
9. Have a parent, older brother or sister go Trick-or-Treating with you.
10. If someone older cannot go with you, Trick-or-Treat with a group of children.
11. Plan your Trick-or-Treat route ahead of time. Pick streets that are well-lighted.
12. Tell your family on which streets you will be Trick-or-Treating.
13. If there is no sidewalk walk facing traffic.
14. Try to Trick-or-Treat when it is still light outside.
