ORDINANCE NO. 1-1995

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADD THE POSITION OF UTILITY OPERATOR AND MAINTENANCE WORKER, PAY GRADE 20, WITHIN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.

Section 1 That Chapter 17 of the Code of Ordinances be and hereby is amended by the addition of the following position:

36.084 UTILITY OPERATOR AND MAINTENANCE WORKER

(1) Class characteristics: Under the general supervision of all Supervisors, shall assist in maintaining and operation of streets and all utility lines, water, sewer and trash and perform related work as required.

(2) General duties and responsibilities: (a) Maintain and repair streets, sidewalks, and maintenance of streets, water lines, sewer lines and storm drains. (b) Perform maintenance on all utilities when needed. (c) Be able to use and test street appliances and have knowledge of electrical, water and local laws. (d) Have good written ability to operate heavy trucks and perform other maintenance duties to perform heavy equipment under adverse weather, some mechanical ability, good physical condition, ability to maintain good relations effective working relationships with employees, officials and the general public.

(3) Training and experience shall consist of graduation from high school or equivalent to equipped operating experience. Must possess the ability to follow vital written instructions. Must obtain all required licenses.

(4) Special knowledge, ability, and abilities include thorough knowledge of streets, water drainage utility lines, and maintenance of distribution and sewer plants, ability to diagnose problems and repairs of distribution, water, sewer, and drainage equipment to repair of distribution/utility lines, ability to operate equipment to repair of distribution/utility lines, accurate reports; ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing.

(5) Additional requirements: (a) Special licensing requirements: Must possess a valid Commonwealth of Kentucky driver's license. (b) Physical fitness and medical: Must be able to lift, carry, push, pull, and move material. (c) License: Must possess a valid driver's license. (d) License: Must possess a valid driver's license.
