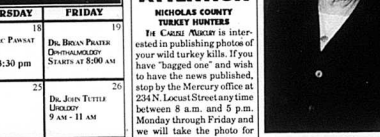

Five Years Ago...

After a seven year decline, the number of cattle has rebounded across the nation. As a matter of fact, Kentucky enjoyed the largest increase in the nation, and now leads all states in the Southeast in beef production, according to the University of Kentucky. Kentucky now ranks eleventh in the U.S. in the number of cattle and ninth in beef production.

Nicholas County ranks last in the state with 21,000 head of cows and calves, according to a January inventory. Most of these are beef cattle. There are only 12 dairies in the county and about 90 beef operations, according to the Nicholas County extension office.
