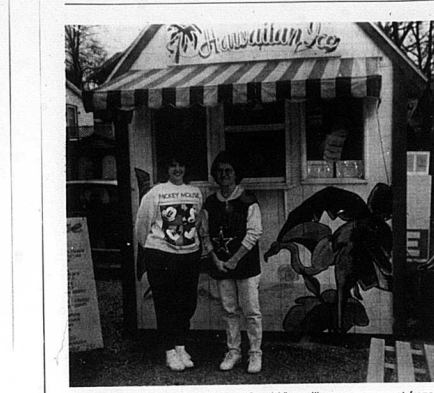
The Kentucky State Fair has and that includes a chance at winning a blue ribbon in one of 28 competitive entry departments. The deadline for entering most contests is July 5, except for livestock in which case the deadline is July 10. The 93rd annual Kentucky State Fair will be August 15 through August 25 at the Kentucky Fair and Exposition Center in Louisville.

The State Fair board has added two new cooking contests for 1996. Mark's Feed Store Bar-B-Que contest will require contestants to make a hot or cold salad, side dish, main course, and using one of the two Marks Feed Store Barbecue sauces. Also new to the culinary stage will be the Rudy's Farm County Sausage contest. Contestants can make a hot dinner dish or a hot or cold appetizer using any variety of Rudy's Farm County Sausage.

Other special cooking contests scheduled for the 1996 Kentucky State Fair include the Pillsbury Refrigerated Pastry Championship, Egan Williams Bourbon Cooking Competition, Neale Choco-Bake Challenge, The Cookbook Cottage Presents One Pot Herb and Spice Cooking, Sure-Jell and the Holiday and the John Conti Coffee Cake Contest.

Two new categories have been added to the textile department. Contestants in Handkerchief and Dupionette stitch will take place for the first time this year. Competitions for silk ribbon embroidery and Christmas stockings have also been added. Junior classes for Christmas and Holiday decorations and stitched Christmas ornaments have also been added to the textile department. The fine arts and crafts department will feature a new category for three-dimensional stained glass objects.

The entry fee for most of the State Fair's 28 competitive entry departments is \$4.00, except for the livestock departments. No entry fee is charged in the dairy product, ham, home brew, and wine departments. Most departments have open competition while some are complete rules, instructions and entry forms for all entry departments and the special cooking contests are available in the 1996 Kentucky State Fair entry catalog. Entry catalogs are free to anyone interested.

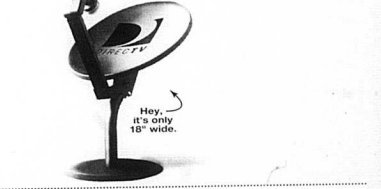
