State Auditor releases County's Clerk's and Sheriff's report

FRANKFORT — State Auditor Ed Hattebitt today released his audit of the 1994 financial statements of the Nicholas County Clerk and Sheriff. As Auditor of Public Accounts, Hattebitt is responsible for auditing the accounts and financial transactions of Kentucky's county governments and state agencies. State law requires the Auditor to conduct annual audits of county clerks and sheriffs.

The County Clerk's responsibilities include collecting certain taxes, issuing licenses, maintaining county records and providing other services. The Clerk's office is funded through statutory fees collected in conformity with these duties.

The Sheriff's responsibilities include collecting real estate taxes, providing law enforcement and performing services for the county fiscal court and courts of justice. The Sheriff's office is funded through statutory commissions and fees collected in conjunction with these duties.

The audit report states that the Clerk and Sheriff's financial statements fairly present the receipts, disbursements and access fees in conformity with accepted accounting principles.

The courthouse downspouts were painted and dried by hanging them on sections of scaffolding.

Board of elections lists Nicholas County voters

The State Board of Elections has a list of the names of the Nicholas County voters who voted in the November 7, 1995 election to the local library for public inspection. The board usually receives complaints that illegal aliens, convicted felons, deceased persons and persons who have moved out of Kentucky continue to show up on voter records. The board approved the project last year as a way to recognize and to show appreciation to persons who made the effort to vote, board chairman Secretary of State John Y. Brown III explained.

The state board is again making a concerted effort to increase voter registration and turnout for the coming primary election. Posting the names of those who voted in the last election is one of several projects.
