ORDINANCE NO. 5, 1996
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 51.41 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, INCREASING THE TAP-IN FEE FOR WATER AND SEWER.
SECTION 1. That Section 51.41 of the Code of Ordinances be and hereby is amended to read as follows:
WATER AND SEWER TAP-IN FEE
51.41. WATER AND SEWER TAP-IN FEE.
A) The following charges shall be collected for tapping in city services:
1/2" water tap \$100
1" water tap \$180-200-250
2" water tap \$250
4" sewer tap \$300
6" sewer tap \$400
B) For all lines running over 25 feet to the property line, there shall be an additional fee for time and cost of pipe added to tap fee.
C) For all taps that are of larger size there shall be charged a fee according to additional cost of work and materials to the city.
SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
