TURKEY SEASON TO OPEN IN APRIL

For the first time ever, turkey season will open state-wide in Kentucky. This year's 14-day spring/obedient season runs April 17-30.

The spring season limit is two birds, both of which must have visible beards. Only one turkey may be taken per day.

During the spring season, shooting hours are one-half hour before sunrise to 1:00p.m.

Don't forget that calling or attempting to call wild turkeys using any call to mimic the sounds made by a wild turkey is prohibited from March 1 until the opening day of spring turkey season. However, locator calls
