hay. If only lower quality hay is available, it should be supplemented with additional protein and energy. Johns suggested that producers should analyze samples to determine if any supplements are necessary in their hay.

A good vitamin and mineral mix also needs to be fed to the cows because trace minerals are closely related to the quality of immunity produced by the cow.

Johns said producers should watch during calving season to make sure newborn calves nurse soon after birth, since they quickly lose the ability to absorb the immunity found in the colostrum.
