Kentucky farm land value increases 10 percent

Parent During 1995, Kentucky farm land values have increased an average of 10 percent during the last year, due largely to good crops and good pricing... The value of farmland in Kentucky increased from an average of \$136 per acre in 1994 to \$150 per acre in 1995, said Dick Trimble, Extension agricultural economist with the University of Kentucky College of Agriculture. All seven states surrounding Kentucky had significant increases in land values with Ohio leading the pack with an increase of 13 percent. Kentucky, Illinois and Indiana each showed a 10 percent increase. Virginia led the rest of the South with an increase of 4.5 percent increase. While Tennessee and Missouri posted 6.9 percent and 6.7 percent increases respectively, some land appreciated more than the average and some less than the average. Whether and prices will continue to appreciate depends a great deal on farm-related legislation to be enacted into law in Washington in the next few weeks, as well as crop conditions and pricing during 1996. Livestock prices will have an impact.

Transylvania receives highest rating

Transylvania University received the highest ratings for overall quality of education in Kentucky in a large national survey of high school guidance counselors. This second annual study of opinions of the nation's high school guidance counselors was conducted by Collegiate Information Services, a research and dissemination organization with headquarters in Riverside, Calif. The guidance counselors were asked to rate each college or university from a list of over 800 schools throughout the country on 10 characteristics which were considered important to high school students. Some of the characteristics included quality of education, academic programs, leadership opportunities, financial aid opportunities, value for the money and personal attention from faculty.
