



2 Measure around container, then double 2 Measure around container, then double measurement. (For instance: If container measures 13" around, final measurement would be 26") Cut three lengths of yarn using this measurement. Knot ends together, secure end by taping to table, then braid.



3 Glue braided yarn around outside edge of all at bottom. Make two more braids in the same way to finish covering lid. Make two more braids to cover the bottom edge of the container. To Glue braided varn around outside edge of lid finish, decorate container with shells, ribbons, flowers or other embellishments. Let dry. Fill with bath salts.
