Area sailor serving in Bosnia

January 9, 1996 (FHTNC)— Navy Petty Officer 2nd Class Roy A. Bolser, son of Betty L. Hunt of Paris, Ky, is currently in the Adriatic Sea near Bosnia serving with Strike Fighter Squadron 82 embarked aboard the aircraft carrier USS America.

Bolser is one of more than 5,000 Sailors and Marines aboard the ship who are supporting the peace implementation operations in the former Yugoslavia. Bolser's Squadron is part of the 11-ship USS America Battle Group that includes more than 80 tactical aircraft and ships and submarines armed with Tomahawk cruise missiles. Bolser has traveled more than 15,000 miles since leaving Norfolk, Va., in late August. Bolser most recently returned to the Adriatic Sea after being to the Persian Gulf to help enforce a no-fly zone over Southern Iraq. Bolser and fellow Sailors have traveled more than 4,000 miles in just nine days after receiving orders to return to the Adriatic Sea. As the peace implementation forces begin deployment, and around the world, Bolser's unit was already in the Adriatic Sea supporting the Bosnia and the Adriatic since they arrived. Bolser began the deployment in the Adriatic Sea near Bosnia, where the 1,000-foot-long aircraft carrier and its nine aircraft squadrons participated in the 1995 NATO airstrikes against Bosnian Serb military targets in support of U.S. initiatives in Bosnia. Aircraft from Bolser's squadron flew missions during the three-day period that targeted military storage and ammunition depots, anti-aircraft missile defense systems, command and control facilities, and military communications systems.

ASS International Student Exchange Programs (ASSIEP) The students are sponsored by ASSIEP, a nonprofit, public benefit organization, founded by the Swedish Ministry of Education. ASSIEP also cooperates with the Canadian Provincial Ministries of Education and the Australian and New Zealand Departments of Education. ASSIEP is the only organization with these 18 countries. The exchange students arrive during their home country's school year before school begins and return through their home country shortly after school begins. Each ASSIEP student is fully insured, brings his or her own personal spending money and expects to bear his or her own share of household responsibilities, as well as being included in normal family activities and lifestyle.

The students are well screened and qualified by ASSIEP. Families may select the youngsters of their choice from a variety of students' applications, family photos and biographical essays. Students and families are encouraged to begin corresponding prior to the students' arrival.
