

Thousands of students offered college grants

FRANKFORT - More than 20,000 Kentucky students enrolling in postsecondary educational institutions for the 1996-97 academic year have been offered grants from the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority, which include the College Access Program Grant and the Kentucky Tuition Grant. Awards to these students total \$28.7 million, according to Paul Borden, executive director of KHEAA.

Applications for Federal Stafford Loans (both subsidized and unsubsidized) and PLUS Loans for parents are being accepted and processed. In addition, students may establish eligibility for the Federal Plus Grant Program or financial aid available through some Kentucky colleges.

Grant funds in both programs are limited, and those who apply early by March 15 for the 1997-98 academic year will have the best chance of receiving funds.

Without new appeals judge

FRANKFORT - The Hon. Anthony Whitlock, Jr. is the new chief judge of the Kentucky Court of Appeals.

Without replacing Judge Charles Clark, who served the court since its inception in 1976.

A Varieties trustee, Whitlock is a graduate of Thomas More College, the University of Kentucky College of Law and the University of Virginia School of Law.

Prior to his appointment to the court, Whitlock was the first to serve as a deputy clerk and worked as a public defender and as a member of the Westwood County and Kentucky bar associations.

The chief judge is elected by the court for a four-year term. He is the administrative chief of the court and is responsible for its management and operation.

The Court of Appeals is the second appellate court. All cases come to the court on appeal from a lower court or an administrative agency.

The case is not retried. The record of the original trial is reviewed with attorneys presenting the legal issues to the court for a decision.
