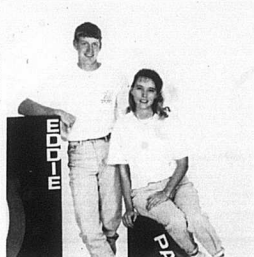

District Judge receives recognition

District Judge Wayne McGee, representing the 10th Judicial District, which includes Harrison, Nicholas, Pendleton and Robertson Counties, was recognized by Kentucky Supreme Court Justice Robert F. Stephens for his efforts in expeditiously disposing of DUI cases.
In a quarterly report submitted to the Administrative Office of the Courts, based on county records, Nicholas County had only 2 DUI cases and Pendleton County had only 6 DUI cases pending and over 50 days. Chief Justice Stephens noted, "the efficient handling of these publicly sensitive cases is commendable and deeply appreciated."
District Judge McGee has served on the bench since 1990.
