LEGAL NOTICE FOR NOMINATIONS FOR BOARD OF TRUSTEES ELECTION FOR THE NICHOLAS COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
The Nicholas County Fire Protection District Election Committee will conduct an election on June 22, 1996, for five (5) members to its Board of Trustees. Any candidate, as well as anyone wishing in such election, must be a property owner who owns and resides in the property within the Nicholas County Fire Protection District (being all of Nicholas County lying outside the city limits of the City of Carlisle) and who is not an active volunteer fire fighter. One trustee will be elected for a two (2) year term and the other for a four (4) year term, and terms to begin July 1, 1996. Nominations must be submitted in writing on a special nomination form in a sealed, addressed envelope, which form and envelope may be obtained from The Nicholas County Fire Department.
