County has 4,741 voters registered for primary election

Nicholas Countians returned to Kentucky's new record high of 2,317,928 registered voters, according to Secretary of State John V. Brown III, chairman of the State Board of Elections. In the last presidential election, only 2,200,000 registered voters were on the rolls of the November general election.

The county now has a total of 4,741 citizens registered to vote in the May 28 primary election, according to Brown. Of that total, 2,318 are registered as Democrats and 233 are registered as Republicans. Those registered as Independents are without any political party preference equals 130.

Teen voter registration across Kentucky this year was nine times greater than the annual average from previous years. Brown attributed the increase to a major effort by the state's registered voter cast a ballot.
