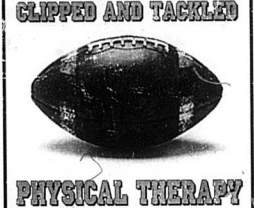
HOMEMAKERS NEWS

Sue Crawford presented the Lions Club work for a report on the work done for the blind and showed tapes on

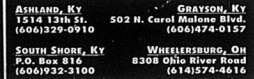
