Throughout October, many people will read articles and view public service announcements about how mammograms are a woman's best defense against breast cancer. New guidelines issued by several cancer prevention organizations suggest that women ages 40-49 should have a mammogram screening every two years.

Women age 50 and over should talk with their phy-

sician about the frequency with which they should have a mammogram screening. Most medical experts suggest annual screenings.

Guidelines further state that women ages 20-39 only need to have a clinical breast examination every three years. Routine mammography is not recommended for this age group.

Mammography remains an extremely important tool in the detection of cancers too small to felt in a physical examination.

Research has shown that routine mammography detects 40 percent of cancers not found on physical examination, thus reducing the death rate from breast cancer by 30 percent.

You and your doctor are also extremely important in detecting cancers. Certain breast abnormalities — dimpling or puckering of the skin, thickening, or surface lumps — can actually be missed by a mammogram.

Some health insurance companies include an annual or bi-annual mammogram in their

normal coverage. Take the time to find out the details of your health insurance coverage.

If you are 40 years old or over, take advantage of the special offers being made this month at your local hospital. Make an appointment to have a mammogram screening performed.

Compared to the costs of treating cancer in its advanced stages, it is far less expensive for breast cancer to be treated and treated early.

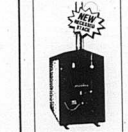

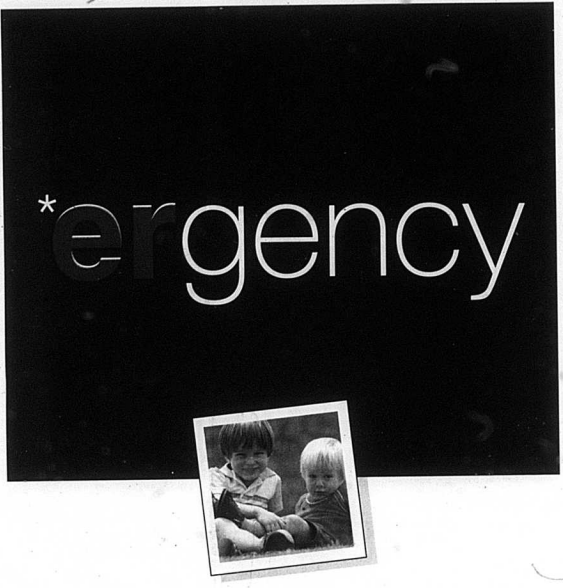
