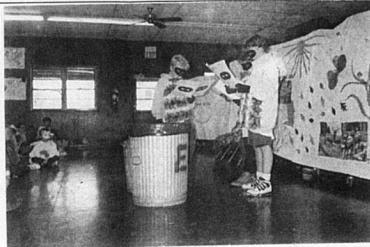

Bingo's are used to raise money for several good causes that can get addicted to them just like you can a bad drug.

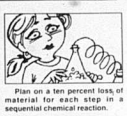
Beauty pageant held in Morehead

The contest will feature two age divisions for boys and eight age divisions for girls.

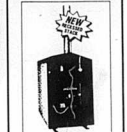
Winners will be eligible to compete for prizes, trophies and cash, plus a chance to represent the city at finals in Dayton, Ohio.
