DEAR DIANE
I have never written to an advice columnist before, but I'm worried sick and don't know where to turn. Over the past year or so, I've watched my beautiful teenage daughter go from a bubbly, happy-go-lucky kid to a withdrawn, unhappy young woman. No matter how hard I try, I can't seem to get through to her to get her open up to me. Her father, who she always got along with so well, can't seem to penetrate her armor either.

Her grades began to drop and she was often absent from school. I've talked to her teachers and they, too, have noticed a big change. They say that she doesn't socialize anymore with her friends and just wants to avoid the school by herself, barely speaking to anyone. This isn't the her I know. How can I get her to open up? She's just not talking to anyone.

DEAR DIANE
Depression in teenagers is more common than a lot of people know. If left untreated or ignored, there could be very serious consequences. I'm not a doctor, but it does sound like your daughter is suffering from depression — the real clinical thing.

Ask your family doctor for a referral to a good psychiatrist who specializes in teen problems. Even if your daughter refuses to go, take her anyway. A good professional will be able to penetrate her shell and get her the help she needs.
