Make Baking Easier

SUGAR COOKIES

1 cup Domino® Granulated Sugar
1 cup Shedd's® Spread Country Cream® Spreadable Sticks 1 1/2 sticks
1 egg
1 tsp vanilla
2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
1 tsp baking powder
1/2 tsp salt

In large mixing bowl, at low speed, cream Domino Sugar and Country Crack 1/2 min. Add egg and vanilla, mix well. Add flour, baking powder and salt, beating at low speed until well mixed.

Roll dough into 30/30 Oh floured board, using floured rolling pin, roll dough until 1/8 inch thick. Cut into shapes. Place on ungreased baking sheets. Bake 8-12 minutes or until lightly browned around edges. Cool. Decorate with frosting. Makes about 4 dozen cookies.
