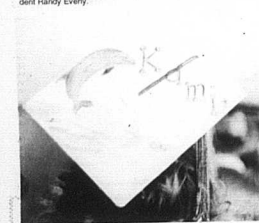
He concluded with the message to make every day the best you can and concluded, "Graduates, you are now ready to begin life's journey."



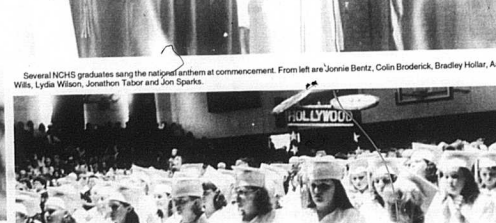
