The senior citizens advisory board still expects to be out in force at the next meeting of Fiscal Court.

The \$10,000 Fiscal Court, effective June 30 if passed in the second reading at the June 11 meeting, has already raised the senior citizens workers to have their hours cut 10 hours.

Their hours were cut from about 25 hours per week. That's about all we could do. We want the center to remain open and we had to cut somewhere," said Barton.
