**Age old whiskey debate underway this May 30-31**

The age-old debate, "Where did bourbon whiskey originate?" will be revisited in a good spirited academic way on May 30-31 at the Georgetown and Scott County Museum and Historic Paris-Bourbon County present its first joint conference on Distilling and Other Settlement Period Industries. The Kentucky Humanities Council is helping to fund the conference with a grant of \$1000. The registration fee of \$25 will cover the cost of refreshments, meals and incidentals. Other costs will be shared by the sponsoring organizations and related groups to whom they have made application.  
 The two-day conference will open at 8:30 p.m. Friday, May 29, on the lawn of Mill Spring, the home of David Stuart at 353 North Broadway. The fun and information-filled evening will get underway to the tune of folk music by Jan Farley, Jim Callaway, Henry Jones and Phil Clark.  
 Joining them at some point in the evening will be Kenney Roseberry a dulcimer hand from Bourbon County.  
 A conference participants enjoy burgo by George Moore, David Kenley will lead a paper dipping event on the banks of Big Spring Branch only a few hundred feet south of the site of the mill where Elijah Craig and the Parker Brothers produced the first shuck of paper in the American West in the early spring of 1793. At 7 p.m. Kentucky's early distillers, led by George McIver and Elijah Craig, will debate the origins of whiskey in Kentucky.

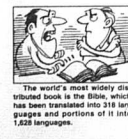
