KSP Commissioner Gary W. Rose stated that the report was made annually because the Kentucky Revised Statutes, Chapter 189.630, require that Kentucky State Police collect and tabulate traffic accident reports submitted to all law enforcement agencies in the Commonwealth.

In 1996, the latest data available, there were 13 accidents in Nicholas County including one fatal accident and three killed. In 1995, there were 107 accidents and one fatality with one death.

The number of persons injured increased from 45 injured in 95 to 53 in 1996. Property damage was on the increase, 75 in 1995 and 84 in 1996.

Kentucky Governor Paul Patton issued the introductory statement, "I am saddened to report to you that the total number of traffic accidents in 1996 increased by five percent and the number of injuries increased by one percent, but somewhat heartened by the fact that the number of fatalities decreased by one percent.
