FRANKFORT, KY (NOVEMBER 21, 1997) Agriculture Commissioner Billy Ray Smith announced today that updated news from Kentucky's tobacco markets will be available each day of the market season...

The hotline is free of charge to all callers and is available by dialing 1-800-432-9800.

This is an important resource for tobacco producers and we're glad to provide it, said Commissioner Billy Ray Smith.

Preliminary information will be available on the hotline until the burley market officially opens Nov. 24. Up-to-date information will be available at the burley, darkfire and dark air-cured tobacco market open.

The recorded messages will give average prices farmers are receiving for burley and different locations, the number of pounds of tobacco sold and pertinent grade and price information.

The messages will be updated around 11 a.m., 2:30 p.m. and again at 6:30 p.m. EST. The morning update will give corrected figures for the previous day's sales, and some grade averages.

Burley, dark and in Kentucky. The late afternoon will give current information of figures from the previous day's sales, and some grade averages.

Information will remain available as long as Kentucky tobacco markets are in operation.
