won a water rate increase, he admitted.

According to the Thursday, Sept. 28 Lexington Herald-Leader, the water district and associations list a total of \$1.3 million last year, according to a report by the Public Service Commission made up in the figures said Nicholas County Water District Secretary Hogue Hall.

Hall said it is typical for water districts under investigation to have a 10 percent water rate increase. However, some of the water districts under investigation have had 20 percent or higher. Mad Creek in Floyd County, Gov. Paul Patton's home county, has the highest water rate loss, exceeding 20 percent.

The PSC has suggested the water districts report their lines or raise rates or even merge with other water district, and Don Mills, executive director of the PSC in The Herald-Leader.

"The day before that article came out, we got a letter in the mail asking us kinds of questions about our financial health," Hall said. "The more cost you pay, the more lines you have, the more depreciation you have. Like this grant we're working on, it's 100 percent of the water district's income."

Hall said he and the water district staff in October 1997. He said the grant will be used to pay for the water district's net loss, according to the report.
