

Clerks attend computer conference

Nicholas County Circuit Court Clerk Sally Walden and Shoptons clerks Tonja Darbo, Janie Dunan, and Melissa Poyman recently attended by 93 circuit court clerks and 319 deputy clerks from across the state.

The program addressed various topics related to the daily job performed by court clerks. The importance of property tracking arrest warrants and recording bail transactions were among topics discussed. Two computer systems, Sustain in each circuit court clerks' office and Courtnet in the AOC's office in Frankfort, are linked to produce criminal history records on individuals convicted of misdemeanor and felonies. Active arrest warrants are also tracked. Criminal records are often checked by potential employers and housing providers.

Conference instructors stressed the importance of properly entering of property entering court convictions on Sustain, due to the far reaching implications of this information.

Other topics included a discussion of proper juvenile case procedures and related confidentiality issues, a review of procedures for issuing various types of driver licenses, an update on the DUI Task Force, a discussion on property disposition of court records, a discussion of liability issues involving court clerks, a review of proper book-keeping procedures, a brief session on submitting records on appeal, and an annual review of the Trust for Life, an organ donor program supported by voluntary public donations received when drivers licenses are renewed. 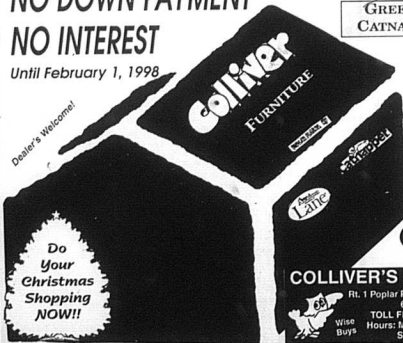
