Lee-Iynn Machining, based on Elm Street for the past

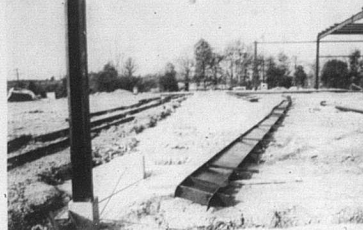
five years, will be moved to a facility currently being constructed of block and metal on Concrete Road near Nicholas County Hospital. The land was purchased from Taylor Mathers.  
"We're very grateful to Tim. The block layout was scheduled to start Friday, Oct. 24."

"The contractors I've got are doing a terrific job," he said Thursday morning, wearing his blue and red Lee-Iynn Machining cap.  
Lewis Breasler Jr. of Winchester is the general contractor. The Winchester company is doing the steel structure, masonry.

Subcontractors will install heating, air conditioning, plumbing, etc.  
The new site is being built on 77 acres, a 200,000 square foot building that's about twice the size of the Elm Street location.

Concrete footers prepare the building for erected steel in the early stages of construction.

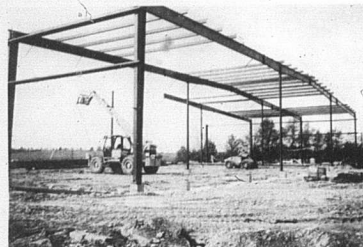
## Incentives would be nice Carlisle is home for Murrell family

The expansion of Lee-Iynn Machining Inc. was a big step for the Murrell family that was once formed on their minds, said co-owner Bradley Murrell.

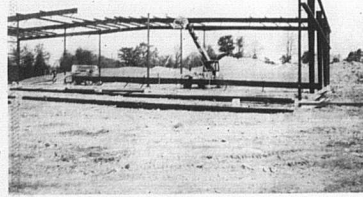

"With the expansion I feel that we're not starting working together to form a small industry together. It's going to hurt in the long run. A little incentive, like the tree people could have a gesture to people who have here. There's a lot of help behind us" smiled Murrell.

The city did just what we needed. Mayor Clark estimated the city's contribution was about \$15,000.

However, Lee-Iynn had the dig dug. "That ended up costing more than we thought. The total rental equipment and operators has been about \$6,000."

Lee-Iynn Machining is named for the murrells to children, Brandon Lee Murrell, a freshman at Parkersburg High School and Heather Lynn Murrell, a fifth grader at Nicholas Elementary School.

Murrell said he's grateful the city agreed to install the eight-inch sewer line to his business. He said a four-inch sewer line would have been effective, especially since there's a room for more industry in the immediate area. "I'm going to look at the future and see what can happen with this."
