National Farm Safety Week is Sept. 21-27; this year's theme is about children's safety

It is impossible to know the exact number of children who are seriously injured or killed on farms each year. Estimates range from 100 to 300 deaths and from 100,000 ture.

Here in Nicholas County, farmers and parents should be particularly aware of potnitial injuries involving tractors, PTOS, hay balars, bush hogs, mowers, plows, discand other implements. Injuries can also occur with tobages. Any 300 deaths and from 100,000 to 250,000 injuries annually.
