Commonly used substance with 87 percent of the respondents reporting lifetime use and 66 percent reporting use in the month before incarceration.

The study also showed that nearly 72 percent of the prisoners interviewed had used an illicit drug at least once, 61 percent reported they had used one during the month prior to incarceration. After marijuana, the most common drugs used were cocaine, amphetamine, LSD and barbiturates.

More than 67 percent of the youngest age group interviewed had used an illicit drug in the month before their incarceration. In addition, the study sheds light on the prisoners' criminal justice histories. On average,

these inmates reported 10.3 prior arrests with the first arrest typically occurring before their 16th birthday.

About 43 percent of the respondents were already under some level of criminal justice supervision at the time of their last arrest. The report describes their histories as "chronic, long-term criminal as a rule."

Family history of criminal involvement was common among the inmates interviewed. Forty-nine percent of the prisoners said they have an immediate family member who had also served time in jail or prison. Also, 37 percent of the sample reported having children living with them at the time of their last arrest.

HIV/AIDS
Another concern the study highlighted was the needs for effective HIV/AIDS prevention programming for inmates.

More than one-third of the people interviewed reported lifetime injection drug use. Of these, about 43 percent said they had used needles that they knew or suspected had been used by someone else, according to the report.

"If we broaden the treatment available in prison, and effectively treat prisoners, particularly young people, for substance abuse, we may stop a cycle of incarceration. This study shows that the problem is not going away, and that younger

people who are now in prison have been using illicit drugs and abusing alcohol at a higher rate than those before them," Townsend said.

"There are serious about rehabilitating people in prison from drug and alcohol abuse treatment are vital steps toward that goal. Otherwise, many of these prisoners, especially those who were under the influence during a crime or breaking the law to get money for drugs and alcohol will continue on a revolving door in and out of prison."

COMBINED FINAL NOTIFICATION AND FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT
The U.S. Department of Agriculture, Rural Development (RD) has received an application for federal assistance from the City of Carlisle, SAIR K96010-1006. The specific elements of the proposed action consist of installing 3,000 feet of 10" 120 PSI line of 8" and 1,200 feet of 3" sewer line and two pump stations to the existing system in order to serve 100 additional customers and the industrial park located in Nicholas County.

USDA/RD has assessed the potential environmental impacts of this proposed action and determined that the location of the proposed sewer system construction would impact the 100 year floodplain. It has been determined that there is no practicable alternative to avoid this impact. The basis of this determination is as follows:

The floodplain would be impacted by the construction of the proposed sewer system due to stream crossings.

The proposed sewer system must be located within the floodplain in order to serve the proposed customers.

The applicant will be required in the RD Letter of Conditions to amend its bylaws whereby it will deny service to any new customer planning to build a floodplain wetland.

The proposed action conforms to applicable state and local floodplain protection standards.

The sewerlines will be laid on public right-of-ways, where necessary, to avoid impacts on any prime farmland and/or wetlands that they be in the vicinity.

There are no cooperating agencies on this project.

It was also determined that the proposed action will not significantly affect the quality of the human environment nor will an environmental impact statement be required.

Any written comments regarding these determinations should be provided within 15 days of this publication to Mr. Thomas O. Fern, State Director, Rural Development, 771 Commonwealth Drive, Suite 200, Lexington, Kentucky 40503. USDA/RD will make no further decisions regarding this proposed action during the 15-day comment period. Requests to review the USDA/RD environmental assessment upon which this determination is based or to receive a copy of it should be directed to the USDA/RD District Office, 200 West First Street, Morehead, KY 40351.
