U.S. Senator Wendell Ford, (D-KY) announced Monday, April 13, that the U.S. Department of Health has awarded a \$ 17,722,913 Welfare-to-Work formula grant to Kentucky.

The grant, which the state will match with \$8,861,457, will be used to target non-occupational parents and welfare recipients to independence as the staff of a high school diploma or GED, low reading and math skills, substance abuse, or a poor work history.

James T. Ford said, "I was assigned to put a stamp on the State of opportunity."

But for welfare reform to be a success, the federal government must work hand-in-hand with state to assure welfare recipients have the tools they need to move to self-sufficient.

The funds will go toward such activities as direct placement into unsubsidized employment, work experience with job placement upon completion, on the job training, community service, and job rotation, such as entrepreneurship or internships in the private sector.

The state will also sponsor pilot projects through the Kentucky Domestic Violence Association, the Department for Mental Health/Mental Retardation Services, and the Division of Substance Abuse. These projects are designed to recognize the relationship between substance abuse and domestic violence.
