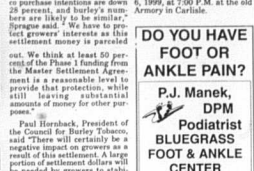

 Despite a decline in the U.S. cancer rate in recent years, Kentucky has higher levels of certain types of cancer. However, lifestyle changes to help reduce the risk of cancer are essential for all cancers. The number of new cancer cases and deaths is declining nationwide because many people have changed their diets and lifestyles. Janet Tyson, assistant professor of food and nutrition for the University of Kentucky College of Agriculture, "However, Kentucky has a slightly higher level of all cancers. The rates are higher for all cancers in women as well as lung and oral cancer in men and oral cancer in women, according to data from the Kentucky Cancer Registry's 1996 Cancer Incidence."
