Company admits to violating burning laws

Placing full-page ads in 12 area newspapers

A Mt. Sterling company will place full-page advertisements in a dozen area newspapers, including The Carlisle Mercury, to inform the public that it had violated state open burning laws.

In return for reduction of the fine, we have agreed to publish this notice and inform the public about outdoor burning laws," says the ad purchased by David Johnson Jr. and Arthur J. Walker Jr., partners in Friendship Properties, Inc., a Mt. Sterling development company.

The ad campaign, estimated at \$11,000, was Walker's idea, Daniel said.

"It was a positive thing they took upon themselves to do more bang for their buck," Daniel said. He added that Walker and Johnson wanted to use their own names in the ad, instead of the company name, to bring more attention to what the ad

was promoting.

The ads have the potential to reach 300,000 people, Daniel said.

This is the first time a notice of this type has been published in this area," he said.

The campaign's result will be to help prevent soil and businesses they can't burn items illegally, and letting the public know what the laws are.

"If the public sees (illegal burning) happening, they could call us," Daniel said.

Outdoor burning is generally illegal except for camp fires, or burning leaves or heavy vegetation for farming purposes.

Burning down a building or burning scrap wood from a building is legal. Fires can give off toxic gases "which are not good for people and are certainly not good for the environment," according to the ad.

In addition to The Mercury, the ad will be published in the Lexington Herald Leader, Mt. Sterling Advocate, the Bull County News Outlook, the Bourbon Times, The Clay City Times, the Licking Valley Courier, The Carlisle Mercury, the Madison County News, Greenup County News-Times, the Olive Hill Times and The Winchester Sun.

Among Kelly's interviewees, Leo Elmer interviewed the war-priest strike on Pearl Harbor. Fred Reed lived through the horrors of the Bataan Death March. Benjamin Butler helped capture Monte Pantano and Monte Cassino. Harold Heaton survived the Stalag 17 prison camp, and Paul and Joe Summe were among the first to land in the fight for Iwo Jima where three other men from Springfield participated in the same battle.
