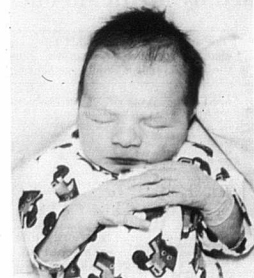

USDA offers rental subsidies for low income housing

WASHINGTON Agriculture Under Secretary Jim Long Thompson has announced that the USDA is reducing operating costs and improving customer service with a new "Industry Interface" software package for a rural housing program that offers rental subsidies to 450,000 low income rural American families.

By reducing the need for duplicative data entry and paperwork transaction, USDA estimates the new system will save \$24 million in operating costs for its Rural Rental Housing Program during the next five years.

Turning paperwork into data is one of the goals of Vice President Gene in his directive to reinvent the federal government. Long Thompson said this data automation project is an excellent example of how we at USDA are doing just that to save taxpayer dollars and improve customer service to rural America.

In its quest to eliminate the plight of substandard housing from rural America, USDA has helped finance the construction of more than 18,000 apartment buildings or other multi-family housing complexes in rural communities that lack decent, affordable rental housing.

Shubert estimates that the new system will save USDA 29 staff years annually while home owners will save 64 staff years. When the Industry Interface is fully installed in January 1998, the cost savings should reach about \$6.8 million annually.

USDA housing staff will no longer be tied up handling and sorting mail and doing red tape. The new system will save 64 staff years.

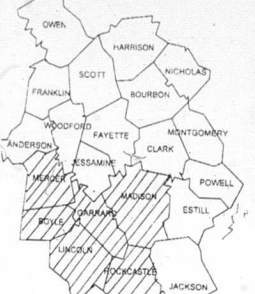
