Pacesetters Festival scheduled for July

On Thursday, July 23, some 2,000 older persons from throughout the state who have taken up walking for fitness and fun will help kick-off the summer Bluegrass State Games with a Governor's Pacesetters Health Festival in Frankfort.

The Office of Aging Services in the Cabinet for Families and Children will sponsor the festival, which will be held at the Farham Dudgeon Civic Center. The festival will include a health fair, dance clinic and a variety of special entertainment.

Governor Paul Patton will present the annual Pacesetters awards for the Most Miles Walked by a Physically Challenged Pacesetter. The award ceremony will be held at 11:30 a.m.

This year's winners are Ray Douglas, "Chick" Fortney, 60, of Harlan and Mary Watkins, 81, of Frankfort.

Fortney won in the Most Miles Walked category with 4,027 from June 1, 1998 to May 30, 1998. For 20 years, Fortney managed his own journalistic business. He is retired now and is a regular participant in activities at the Harlan Senior Center where he assists with fund raising projects.

Ms. Watkins, who uses a wheelchair, won in the Physically Challenged category. She "walked" 1,115 miles during the period.

She is retired from Texas Instruments and is a very active volunteer at the Franklin County Senior Citizens Center. She hopes to work as a law paralegal and used her old "rolling chair" for exercise.

The winners each receive a \$100 gift certificate from the Tourism Development Cabinet redeemable at any Kentucky State Park.

The Frankfort Regional Medical Center sponsors the Pacesetters' activities.

The Pacesetters program was started in 1987 for persons 55 and older to encourage seniors across the state to participate in a walking program. For more information in the Pacesetters' Program call Owen Cobb at (502) 564-0939.
