ASVAB test assesses students career skills

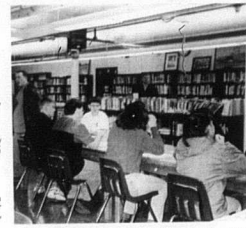

High school students participated in ASVAB testing Monday and Tuesday.

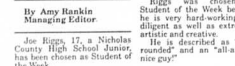
Galbraith to serve as officer for KUNA
