VanMeter awarded \$500 in International Science Fair

Abby VanMeter, a Nicholas County High School Senior, received an award for being a finalist in a recent science fair. VanMeter competed in the International Science and Engineering Fair in Dallas-Fort Worth, Texas May 10-16.

VanMeter placed fourth in the category of Zoology in which she competed during the recent science fair. She was awarded \$500 for her research and presentation October of 1996, titled "An Evaluation of HIV Anti-Viral Therapies on Equine Infectious Anemia Virus."

The project research concluded that HIV in horses was

similar to that in humans and that a certain anti-inflammatory agent was successful in treating the disease in the animal.

She has won other competitions at the Louisville Junior Science and Humanities Symposium where she was awarded a four-year tuition scholarship to the University of Louisville.

VanMeter will be graduating this year and plans to attend the University of Louisville in the Fall.

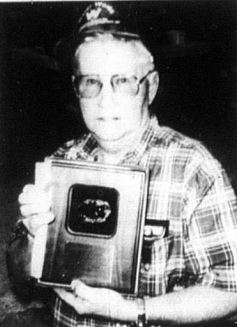
