

MSU Homecoming slated

The more than 21,000 Montanans who attend the Homecoming activities which run Friday through Sunday, Oct. 16-18, on the campus.

Among the highlights of the weekend will be the arrival of the game ball by special delivery to MSU's homecoming grounds with Thomas Stone College on Saturday, Oct. 17.

Parachutists from the U.S. Army 101st Airborne Division, arriving via helicopter, will deliver the game ball to the yard line of Jacobs Field in Joplin Stadium, prior to a 1:30 p.m. kick-off.

A weekend of activities is scheduled for alumni and guests this year, including the annual fish fry, an assortment of receptions and a luncheon for the classes of 1938 and 1948, according to Bill Barber, director of alumni relations and development.

Ranking of the activities will be the annual faculty/staff office at the Alumni Center from 8:30 to 11 a.m. on Friday.

A Welcome Reception for the university's guests will be held by the Office of Development and Alumni Relations and the Alumni Association on Friday from 5 to 6:30 p.m. at the Mountain House on the main level of the building.

This event gives early

arrivals a number of opportunities to visit with friends and faculty staff.

The MSU Volleyball Team will host an Invitational Tournament at Wetherby Gym, beginning Friday at 8 p.m. and running throughout the day on Saturday.

Six individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the Eagle athletic program will be inducted into the MSU Athletic Hall of Fame at a dinner in the Crager Room, Adams Duran University Center (ADUC), on Friday beginning at 7 p.m. This year's inductees include football greats Billy Poo, Jack Smith and Claude Clayton; basketball's Robert Counts; volleyball coach Laradon Brown and basketball's Connie Appleman.

Tickets are \$12 and must be purchased in advance by calling the Alumni Center at 755-2089.

To conclude the day's agenda, the Student Government Association and the Student Activities Council will host the Bluefield Ball on Friday, Oct. 16, from 8 until 11 p.m. in the grill, ADUC.

Tickets are \$5 per person and may be purchased at the door.

Saturday's activities start with the American Heart Association "Heart Walk," a five-mile trek which begins at 8 a.m. on the lawn of Laughlin Health Building.
