Sex offender notice effective Jan. 15

Justice Cabinet secretary Dan Cherry announced Jan. 15 as the effective date of Kentucky's version of Megan's Law, a community notification process called an "additional tool" in keeping our families and children safe from sex offenders.

Megan's Law was a strong portion of Gov. Paul Patton's criminal justice reform package passed by the 1998 General Assembly that involves notifying the public of the release of a convicted sex offender.

The Justice Cabinet has other state agencies to implement Megan's Law and to inform citizens of its intent.

Cost of first-class stamp rises to 33 cents The U.S. Postal Service will be increasing the cost of first class stamps one cent to 33 cents, effective Jan. 11. It will be the first overall increase in postal rates in four years.

Priority Mail up to 22 cents, \$1.50; the 50-cent rate is also charged for all matter sent in the "flat rate" envelope.
