### CITY OF CARLISLE ORDINANCE 5 - 1999

#### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 52.04 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES INCREASING TRASH COLLECTION RATES.

Be it ordained by the City of Carlisle:

Section 1. That Section 52.04 of the Code of Ordinances be and hereby is amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 52.04 TRASH COLLECTION SERVICE CHARGES

(A) Trash collection service charges for one-family residence and apartments shall be \$9.00 per month, per residence, and apartment.

(B) Monthly trash collection service charges for offices, business establishments, and industrial plants shall be as follows:

(C) The City Council shall establish trash collection service charges, based on current charges for that classification, for each new industrial plant, business establishment, office, or residence that may come into being within the corporate limits of the city.

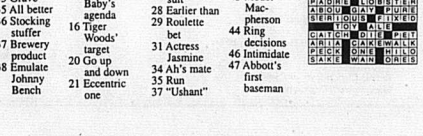
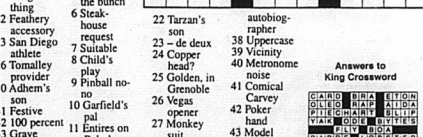
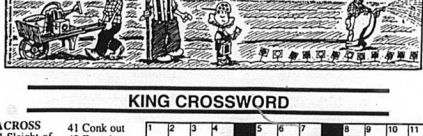
