CLARK, SR., WEST AND NORTH OF THE CITY, CONTAINING 68.272 ACRES, AND 1445 ACRES MORE OR LESS. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CARLISLE, KENTUCKY: Section 1. That the City hereby express its intent to annex to the City boundary those certain tracts of land containing 68.272 acres, and 1445 acres, more or less, which properties are owned by the Nicholas County Board of Education, and William C. Clark, Sr., respectively. Section 2. That the properties are adjacent to the City, urban in nature, and it is desirable to the City to annex such tracts. Section 3. That the tracts to be annexed are more particularly described in annex map "City of Carlisle, Kentucky, Kentucky Annexation," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. Section 4. That following a public hearing and the recommendation of the Planning Commission pursuant to KRS 100.209, the zoning for such annexed tracts shall be as determined by the Planning Commission. Fire hazard continues

Relief from rainfall has been short-lived in Kentucky. In fact, the Commonwealth is still experiencing an extreme drought. Consequently, officials with the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources and the Kentucky Division of Forestry continue to caution all hunters and other outdoor enthusiasts to take special care while moving through the woods. Extremely dry conditions caused by the drought have made the grass and woodlands very dry and fire can be ignited easily. "As a precaution, fires should be taken with any type of heat source," cautions Fire Management Chief Bernie Anderson with the Kentucky Division of Forestry. "The drought has produced extremely dry conditions, making it very susceptible to fire."
