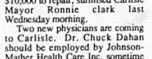




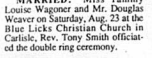

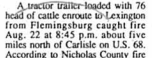
5 Years Ago

Vandalism struck the Carlisle Cemetery sometime last Tuesday evening, leaving 40 gravestones overturned, some destroyed.



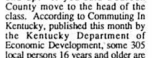
25 Years Ago

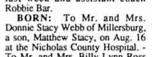
15 Years Ago

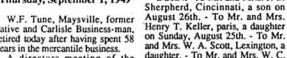
70 Years Ago

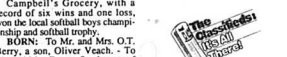
