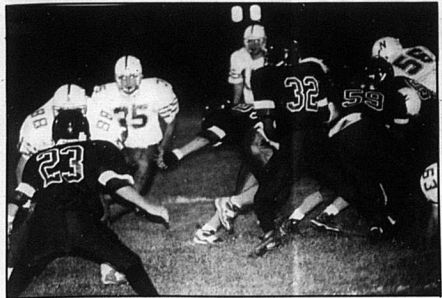

1. Completed application must be returned to the Trust in the preaddressed envelope and postmarked no later than Oct. 8.
A. Application must be printed in black ink only.
3. All entries must be clearly printed in the designated boxes.
4. Photographs of applications will not be accepted.
5. Allocation of basic quota among multiple quota owners must equal 1998 basic quota as printed in section II.
6. Allocation of payment funds among multiple growing farms must equal 1998 payment funds as preprinted in section III.
7. Allocation of payment funds among multiple growing farm/tenants must equal 1998 payment funds as preprinted in section IV.
8. Completed application must contain names, addresses and social security numbers for all parties that are eligible to receive compensation.
9. Completed application must contain signature(s) from farm operator, quota owner, growing farm (if applicable) and grower/tenant(s) (if applicable).
10. For assistance contact: local USDA/SEA office, local USEA office, local USEA office, local USEA office.
Remember, any application that does not include the signature and social security number of an eligible party will be considered incomplete and payments will not be made.
