the animal.

PILE DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE. It shall be unlawful for the owner or keeper of any dog, either licensed or unlicensed, regardless of the age of the dog, to allow the dog to be at large and unattended or to run in any street, park, lawn, garden, schoolyard, playground, or on any other public or private property.

NOISE DISTURBANCE. No person shall keep or harbor any dog within the city which, by frequent and habitual barking, howling, or yelping, creates unreasonable loud and disturbing noises of such a character, intensity, and duration as to disturb the peace quiet, and good order of one or more of the inhabitants of the city.

NOISE DISTURBANCE. Any person who violates any provision of this chapter for which another penalty is not already otherwise provided shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$500 for each offense. Each of two or more separate infractions shall constitute a separate offense.
