This program was an orientation designed for the new circuit court clerks by the Circuit Court Clerks Association, Education Committee and the Administrative Office of the Courts.

The program content was intended to familiarize the

new clerk with the rules and procedures governing the absence of all judicial officer, the circuit clerk is an elected official of the Kentucky Court of Justice and is the official record keeper of the district and circuit courts.

The circuit court clerk's office is responsible for preparing bonds and affidavits, maintaining records, files and dockets; collecting fees, fines and bond money; paying ; jurors, commissioners and witnesses;

issuing driver licenses, and summoning jurors. In the absence of all judicial officer, the circuit clerk may issue warrants prepared by the Commonwealth or County Attorney.

Glickman reminds farmers to sign up for USDA Programs that can help

On December 5, 2000, Agriculture Secretary Dan Glickman today reminded farmers of pending application deadlines for emergency assistance programs.

"There are many USDA programs that are available to farmers this year to help them through difficult times," said Glickman. "I urge farmers to call or visit their local USDA office to ensure that they know about all the help they may be eligible for and to sign up before the deadline."

Application deadlines for programs previously announced this year are as follows:

- **2000 Oilseed Program:** \$600 million in payments is available to the more than 600,000 producers of the 2000 crops of certain oilseeds. Eligible oilseeds include canola, crambe, flaxseed, mustard, rapeseed, safflower, sesame, soybean and sunflower. Application deadline is January 12, 2001.
- **Wool and Mohair Market Loss Assistance Program:** Approximately \$11 million in relief is available for farmers who suffered economic loss due to low prices during the 1999 marketing year. Application deadline is December 29, 2000.
- **2000 Lamb Meat Adjustment Assistance Program:** Approximately \$10 million is available to producers whose lamb carcasses meet minimum grade specification. Application deadline is August 30, 2001.
- **Dairy Market Loss Assistance (DMLA III):** Payments to operations that received assistance under DMLA II will be automatically issued to producers later this month. Payments will also be available to new operations and to operations that did not have 12 months of marketing established under DMLA II, and will be based on October 1998-September 2000 marketings. The four-week sign-up period for these producers will begin in late January 2001.
- **Apple Market Loss Assistance:** Up to \$100 million will be available to apple producers to help offset low market prices experienced during the 1998 and 1999 crop years. The sign-up period will begin on January 18, 2001.
