Thomas G. Fern, state director of USDA Rural Development attended a ceremony to commemorate National Homeownership Week, at the site where Corrine Adair's new house will be built.

She has lived in the family home for 65 years and raised three generations of children; however the dwelling has become structurally deficient and is not economically feasible to repair. "It has always been my dream to live in a new home," said Mrs. Adair.

She contacted the USDA Rural Development Office in Flemingsburg for assistance. Richard Tillery, Community Development Manager, visited Mrs. Adair's determination was made that she was eligible for a RH 502 low-interest loan to construct a new house. Mrs. Margaret Hunter of the Nicholas County Community Action Program assisted Mrs. Adair with application packaging.

It is always a pleasure to be in my home-land of the state and it is very rewarding to see progress - whether it be infrastructure, housing or economic development related activities. We are especially proud of our accomplishments in assisting low-to-moderate income families in rural areas like Nicholas County, attain the American dream of homeownership," said Fern. "All Rural Development homeownership programs enable borrowers to finance up to one hundred percent of the value of their home, removing the downpayment barrier which often prevents low-income families from owning a home."
