father Henry Meicalle to our state capitol was the most exciting trip I had ever had. We were on our way to the ceremony, just approaching the steps of what is now known as the old capitol building when a shot rang out and my father-in-law died.

The controversy stemmed from the November state election in which the Republican candidate, W.S. Taylor, supposedly defeated Geobel, the Democratic nominee by 1,000 votes. Geobel immediately contended that fraud was involved and a special legislative committee was appointed to investigate.
