**Be Sure Its Really Asprin To Help Prevent A Heart Attack**  
(NAPS)—For years physicians have been advising their patients to take an aspirin a day to cut the risk of repeat heart attacks. But a recent Harvard Medical School study found that nearly one in four Americans who should be taking aspirin a day to help prevent a second heart attack are mis-medicated by taking a non-aspirin analgesic. Boasting for the wrong product leaves patients with an unnecessarily high risk for a second heart attack, stroke or even death. And millions more who might benefit from aspirin therapy aren't taking it at all.

The national study revealed that as many as 2.7 million Americans may be incorrectly using such common over-the-counter pain relievers as ibuprofen (Advil) and acetaminophen (Tylenol) to prevent or treat cardiovascular disease (CVD) instead of or in combination with aspirin.

This is a major public health issue that can be addressed in part through education and increased public and healthcare provider awareness," according to Dr. Charles Hennekens, a study co-author and one of the world's leading researchers on the benefits of aspirin and heart disease. "A significant number of people mistakenly believe that non-aspirin analgesics are the same as aspirin. They are not. Getting the message out should be a priority for all of us concerned about the prevention and treatment of CVD."

**Choose Aspirin Wisely**  
Not all aspirins are the same. Many doctors recommend safety-coated aspirin, such as Ecotrin, that passes safely through the stomach and offers special protection against side effects associated with long-term aspirin therapy.
