Christmas Island was exciting enough before the new additions were added.

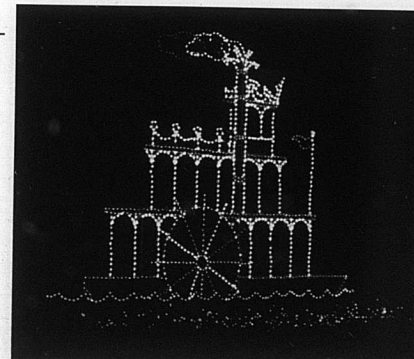
However, now Christmas Island is bigger and better than ever.

Nonetta wreath and the Twelve Days of Christmas.

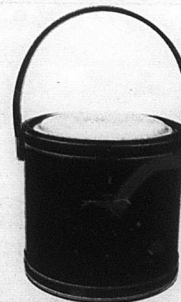
You can't help but to enjoy the drive down Cassidy Cane Lane to Toyland.
